

# INCOMING GOODS

## Basic regulations

Unless other requirements are agreed when the goods are ordered, the following basic regulations apply, which can be extended by the ADR or any other regulations.

ACCEPTANCE PERIODS	
<b>Packaged goods</b>	
Monday - Thursday:	8:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m./ 1:00 p.m. - 2:00 p.m.
Friday:	8:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m.
<b>Tankers</b>	
Monday - Thursday:	7:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m.
Friday:	7:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m.

  

VEHICLE REQUIREMENTS PROFILE	
<b>Tankers</b>	
Delivery temperature max. 50°C / min. 10°C above freezing point of the goods	
3" tank connections	
Fall protection in the area of the dome cover (handrail)	
<b>Packaged goods</b>	
Drums banded on pallets	
Bagged goods wrapped or affixed on pallets	
Unloading must be possible with pallet truck or forklift	
Straps and tensioning materials to secure the load (especially for partial loads)	

  

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS PROFILE	
<b>Driver skills</b>	
Vehicle knowledge	
Speaks German or English	

  

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS PROFILE	
<b>Driver's personal equipment</b>	
When transporting hazardous goods, the driver requires equipment in accordance with ADR 8.1.5.2.	
If transporting for classes 2.3 or 6.1, also equipment in accordance with ADR 8.1.5.3.	
Accompanying documents are to be carried in accordance with ADR 8.1.2	

  

NECESSARY ACCOMPANYING DOCUMENTS	
CMR or bill of lading with precise product name and Reininghaus order number	
Analysis certificate in advance by e-mail to <a href="mailto:supplier-coa@reininghaus.de">supplier-coa@reininghaus.de</a>	
<b>For tankers:</b> Cleaning certificate for tank and pipes with details of the previous load	

  

TANKER UNLOADING/LOADING TIME	
When the order is placed, delivery time slots are specified by Reininghaus-Chemie. These must be adhered to in order to guarantee the unloading process runs smoothly. Deviations from the specified delivery slot must be coordinated in advance.	
Tankers are weighed on scales inside the plant and a maximum weighing difference of 0.5% is accepted. If the supplier's weight ticket is not available, the weight determined by RC is binding for the calculation.	
Any downtime costs incurred, which may also be charged by third parties, must be paid by the party responsible (e.g. in the event of delayed or postponed deliveries).
